Fracture Liaison Services (FLS) have been recommended as the optimal method for closing this gap in care. The IOF Capture the Fracture® program was launched in 2012 with the aim of facilitating the implementation of Post-Fracture Care Coordination programs/ Fracture Liaison Services (FLS) for secondary fracture prevention. In this webinar, Dr. Sheung Wai Law and Dr. Albert Hsu will provide an updated overview of the post-fracture care context in Hong Kong. ### Prof. Serge Ferrari

Full Professor and Head of the Service and Laboratory of Bone Diseases, Geneva University Hospital, Switzerland. As well as IOF's Vice-Chair of the Committee of Scientific Advisors, he is the President of the Swiss Association Against Osteoporosis (ASCO/SVGO) and has been President of the Swiss Bone and Mineral Society (SBMS). Prof. Ferrari has received numerous awards for his work, including the prestigious IOF Olof Johnell Science Award in 2016. He is on the editorial boards of key journals in the bone field and has published more than 350 articles and book chapters, with research focus on the pathophysiology of osteoporosis, determinants of bone fragility in children and the aging, and the mechanisms of action of osteoporosis drugs.



### Dr. Sheung Wai Law

Dr Law Sheung Wai is Assistant Dean (Health Systems), Clinical Professional Consultant, Department of Orthopaedics and Traumatology. In a professional capacity, Dr Law is Chief-of-Service, Department of Orthopaedics and Traumatology, Alice Ho Miu Ling Nethersole Hospital; Chief-of-Service, Department of Orthopaedic Rehabilitation, Tai Po Hospital; President-Elect, The Hong Kong College of Orthopaedic Surgeons and Vice – President Fragility Fracture Network, HKSAR.
